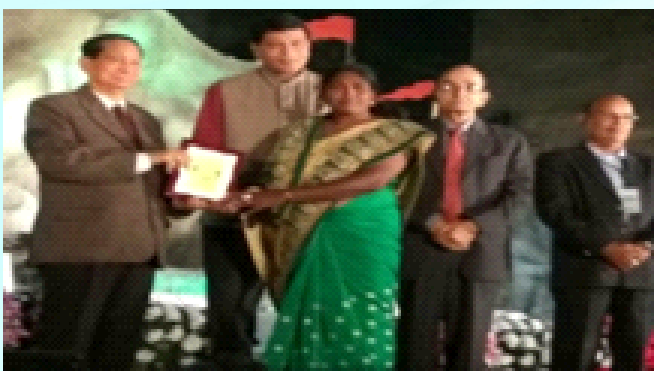

The **“SATYABHAMA DEVI WELFARE TRUST ”** has been registered under the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 vide Regn. no. 543 dt. 07.04.2007. The trust has been constituted with a Chairman, a Vice – Chairman, two Trustees and a Managing Trustee, the present incumbent being **Ms. Niroja Laxmi Mohapatra**.

MISSION: Besides other social welfare activities, the Trust has established in the year 2007 the Satyabhama Devi College for Hearing Impaired to develop the talents of the hearing-impaired students emphasizing on speech/audio therapy and allied communication skills.

INTAKE CAPACITY OF THE COLLEGE: Initially the Govt. of Odisha and the Council of Higher Secondary Education have accorded permission and affiliation for 192 seats in the +2 Arts stream with optional subjects like History, Political Science, Economics, Psychology, Information Technology, English and M.I.L (Odia).

METHOD OF TEACHING: Unlike the normal student's method of teaching, the following specialized methods are being followed to provide effective learning experience to the hearing-impaired students. The special procedure and methodology for communication and concept formation of the hearing-impaired students include.

1. Speech Therapy.
2. Lip-Reading.
3. Oral-Aural.
4. Finger Spelling.
5. Writing and.
6. Sign Language.

To impart an effective teaching to the hearing-impaired students, the skilled faculty members make use of the following technical equipment, namely.

1. Overhead Projector
2. Slide Projector
3. Computer and
4. Loop Induction system

FACILITIES: The college provides facilities such as a Library-Cum-Reading Room with adequate number of reference books and journals, laboratories (both ICT and Psychology), separate common rooms/toilets for boys and girls, counselling room with provision for extra coaching for weaker students. The college has a playground with sports materials.

+3 COURSE: The college started the +3 Arts course in the year 2016 with view to enabling the hearing-impaired students to pursue the degree level higher education which is the FIRST of its kind in the State of Odisha. The Govt. of Odisha as well as the Utkal University have exempted the pledged money and bank deposit to the tune of rupees three lakhs for recognition and affiliation of the degree college. The subjects offered are History (Hons), Political Science (Hons), Psychology, English, M.I.L (Odia) and Environmental Studies.

PLACEMENT : Since the inception of the college 938 students have passed the +2 examination and 175 have successfully completed the +3 degree course. Most of these students have been employed in various government offices, public sector undertakings, private companies of repute as office assistants, computer operators and housekeeping staff. Besides, they have been recruited into both nationalized and private banks. They have also been taken in as teachers in schools specialized in disability learning.
